Finally, have a wonderful weekend and we will see you safe and sound next week .

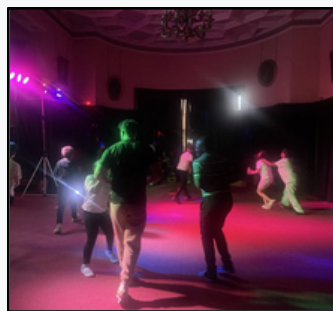
